In November 2022, we delivered a third business enterprise challenge with Year 7 children, this time in Kenton School in Newcastle. Ward Hadaway trainee solicitors rolled up their sleeves and volunteered at each weekly session at school.

Kenton School prides itself with providing a wealth of academic opportunities, their learners benefit from a wide range of extra-curricular activities, designed to help them grow into socially responsible and caring citizens.

As part of their Extra Curricular activities, children took part in a 7-week business enterprise challenge, focusing on environmental issues and technology, explored marketing, sales, innovation and creativity. The children pitched their business ideas to the Ward Hadaway 'judges' at the end of the 7 week challenge.

The competition was tough and the winners of the final pitches and overall business idea went to Smart Box and Thermo.



IGNITING AN INTEREST IN A CAREER IN LAW OR BUSINESS WITH YEAR 7 STUDENTS




We were extremely impressed with the intuition and creativity displayed by the students in converting regular household objects into imaginative business ideas.
